Petitioner moves this Court to stay consideration of his Petition for Review pending this Court's decision in State v. Imokawa, Supreme Court No. 96217-1. Oral argument is set for May 16, 2019.

### III. GROUNDS FOR RELIEF SOUGHT

As grounds for and in support of this motion appellant shows unto the Court as follows:

- 1. This petition arises from a vehicular homicide conviction. In the Petition for Review, petitioner raised the issue that the Court of Appeals opinion in this case conflicted with the Court of Appeals opinion in Imokawa, 4 Wn. App. 2d 545, 422 P.3d 502 (2018). This Court granted review in Imokawa on the issue of whether due process requires jury instructions to plainly tell the jury that the State bears the burden of proving the absence of a superceding cause in a vehicular homicide trial because it negates the essential element of proximate cause.
- 2. The State here filed a "Contingent Cross Petition for Review" -- which this Court decided to treat as an Answer to the Petition. The State also raised the issue of the effect of the *Imokawa* opinion on this case. Contingent Cross Petition for Review (filed 3/25/2019) at 6-7.
- 3. The parties thus agree that the *Imokawa* opinion presents a significant issue vis-a-vis the Court of Appeals opinion in this case. Since this Court is hearing *Imokawa*, it will issue a definitive opinion on that issue. It thus makes sense for this Court to wait and consider the full Petition in this case after it has decided that case.

### IV. CONCLUSION

For the reasons stated above, Petitioner respectfully asks
