Review Reply, filed on September 9, 2019, because no Reply is permitted under RAP 13.4(d).

The Guests acknowledge in their response to the Lange's Motion to Strike that "RAP 13.4(d) in pertinent part states and provides that a party may file a reply to an Answer to a petition for review only if the answering party seeks review of issues not raised in the petition for review." (Guests' Joint and Combined Response and Answer to Lange and Keller Rohrback Law Firm's Motion to Strike Without Waiver, at p. 5) Other than this acknowledgment, however, the Guests' response does not actually address or respond to the Lange's Motion to Strike. They do not dispute that neither the Langes nor the respondents The Coe Family Trust and Trustee Michael A. Coe sought "review of issues not raised in the petition for review" in their Answers to the Guests' amended petition for review.

Because the respondents did not seek review by the Court of any issues not raised in the petition for review, no Reply is allowed under RAP 13.4(d). As such, the Court should strike and not consider Appellants' Petition for Review Reply in ruling on the Guests' amended petition for discretionary review.
