Motion to Strike Declaration of Drew Mazzeo

1. Identity of Moving Party

Respondent, Patrick Cuzdey, asks for the relief designated in Part 2.

2. Statement of Relief Sought

Strike the "Declaration of Attorney Drew Mazzeo," filed October 28, 2019.

3. Facts Relevant to Motion

Cuzdey filed his "Motion to Disqualify Attorney Drew Mazzeo" on October 21. Landes filed a response on October 22. The same day, this Court acknowledged receipt of both the motion and the response, indicating that any reply should be filed by October 25.

Cuzdey filed his Reply on October 25. Landes then filed a "Declaration of Attorney Drew Mazzeo" on October 28.

Paragraph 1 of the Declaration attests to the facts stated in Landes' response to the motion. The remainder of the Declaration presents arguments in response to Cuzdey's Reply.

4. Grounds for Relief

When a party files a motion in the appellate court, a non-moving party is permitted to submit a written answer to the motion. RAP 17.4(e). The moving party is then permitted to submit a written reply to the answer. RAP 17.4(e). Nothing in the rule permits any other papers to be filed after the reply. RAP 17.4(e). "Affidavits and other papers submitted in support of an answer or reply [to a motion] must be served and filed with the answer or reply." RAP 17.4(f) (emphasis added).

Under these rules, the Declaration of Attorney Drew
Mazzeo is entirely improper. It was not filed with the answer, as
required. It is an impermissible attempt to get in the last word
on Cuzdey's motion. The rules give Cuzdey the last word.
Anything filed after the reply is improper and should be
stricken.

5. Conclusion

This Court should strike the Declaration of Attorney Drew Mazzeo, filed October 28, 2019.
