I. Identity of Responding Party, Relief Requested & Introduction.

Respondent City of Bremerton ("City") asks this Court to deny Petitioners' petition for review.

Appellant/Petitioner Robert Norman Thompson ("Thompson") filed a petition for review that included a toxicology report, a jail commitment from Bremerton Municipal Court, a letter from his insurance company, a photograph of his foot taken on September 29, 2018, a photograph of his foot taken on December 31, 2019, a medical record from November 24, 2015, a Kitsap County Superior Court Decision on Appeal filed September 5, 2018, and a Summary from Thompson. He does not state what decision he is appealing, cite to the record, state why review should be granted, attach an appendix, or state the relief sought.

II. Facts relevant to answer.

Thompson has not indicated in his petition what he is seeking reviewed and why. The City is unable to identify facts relevant to an unknown.

III. Grounds for relief and argument.

Under RAP 13.4(b), a petition for review will be granted by the Supreme Court only:

- (1) If the decision of the Court of Appeals is in conflict with a decision of the Supreme Court; or
- (2) If the decision of the Court of Appeals is in conflict with another decision of the Court of Appeals; or

- (3) If a significant question of law under the Constitution of the State of Washington or of the United States is involved; or
- (4) If the petition involves an issue of substantial public interest that should be determined by the Supreme Court.

Thompson has not indicated in his petition what he is seeking reviewed and why, however, the Court of Appeals decision in this case involves none of these issues.

IV. Conclusion.

Thompson's Petition for Review should be denied.
