Three amicus memoranda have been filed in support of Mr. Long's petition for review. None of them address the points raised in the City's answer to the petition for review, starting with the indisputable fact that Mr. Long is not an aggrieved party with standing to seek further review. Instead, *amici* largely repeat arguments made to the Court of Appeals, which the City earlier refuted and the Court of Appeals rejected.¹

To the extent that any amicus seeks to raise a new argument, the City's answer to the petition of review explains why that argument is without merit. *Compare* Brief of Amici Curiae Institute for Justice and Fines and Fees Justice Center (Sept. 25, 2020) *with* Answer to Petition for Review (Aug. 27, 2020) at 6–13; *compare* Brief of WACDL as Amicus Curiae (Sept. 24, 2020) *with* Answer to Petition for Review (Aug. 27, 2020) at 14–16.

CONCLUSION

Mr. Long is not an aggrieved party, and he fails to show any basis for review under RAP 13.4(b). The amicus memoranda do not, either. The Court should, therefore, deny Mr. Long's petition for review.
