### **Part II: Narrative Explanation**

### II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts

This bill would add a new section to RCW 46.20 addressing the safety of new drivers.

The new section would establish a pilot program in Clark County that requires a "New Driver" decal be displayed on any vehicle operated by a person who is under 18 years of age and require a person to perform community service if he or she fails to properly display the "New Driver" decal. This violation would not be a traffic infraction.

This new section would expire on July 1, 2020.

If the violation is not a traffic infraction then it is assumed that the courts would not be part of this process. The courts could not order community service without a violation being filed or a referral sent to the juvenile court. Therefore, it is assumed there would be no judicial impact for the substitute version of this bill.
