**II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts**

Bill Summary:

Section 1 would modify RCW 9.94A.525(3) related to out-of-state convictions. An out-of-state conviction is scored a class C felony equivalent if the offense was a felony under the relevant out-of-state statute and there is no clearly comparable offense under Washington law.

It is assumed that this bill would have minimal impact on the courts statewide.
