Part II: Narrative Explanation

II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts

This bill would allow government agencies to use unmanned aerial vehicles subject to limitations on the collection of information .

Section 4(2) would require law enforcement agencies to obtain a warrant or order from a superior court for use of an unmanned aerial vehicle under certain conditions.

Section 4(3) authorizes superior courts to issue warrants or orders for use of unmanned aerial vehicles by law enforcement agencies .

Section 6 allows any person to bring legal action against any government agency that knowing violates the conditions and limitations of this bill.

There would be additional warrants and orders obtained from the courts but there is no judicial data available to estimate how many there would be. It is assumed that the cost to process the additional warrants would be less than \$50 ,000 per year.

There is no judicial data available to estimate the number of cases that would be filed against government agencies for violation of this bill. It is assumed that there would be very few cases and the cost to the courts each year would be less than \$50 ,000.
