II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts

RCW 9.94A.501(4)(e)(i) would be amended to include: This subsection (4)(3)(i) applies only to offenses committed prior to the effective date of this section. Sub-section (ii) would be added to state: Has a conviction for a domestic violence felony offense where domestic violence was plead and proven and that was committed after the effective date of this section . The state and its officers, agents, and employees shall not be held criminally or civilly liable for its supervision of an offender under this subsection unless the state and its officers, agents and employees acted with reckless disregard .
