## **Part II: Narrative Explanation**

### **II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts**

In addition to the changes in the previous version, the engrossed substitute bill would also amend RCW 40.24.070 to define when the Washington State Patrol could use the records. The judicial impact is not changed by this addition.

A new section would be added to RCW 80.36 that would direct a law enforcement agency to not provide call location to a person that the agency reasonably believes has a history of domestic violence or stalking. A wireless telecommunications provider may establish protocols for voluntary disclosure to law enforcement. Law enforcement requests for call location information are limited to emergency situations and no other investigations. Law enforcement must also check for any court order restricting contact. The state emergency management division E911 office must maintain a database of emergency contact information.

This legislation is not expected to cause any judicial impact to AOC or to the courts.
