II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts

The bill would expand eligibility for DNA sample collection under RCW 43.43.754 to include persons acquitted by reason of insanity. The list of crimes subject to DNA collection is the same as for persons convicted. There may be small expenditure impacts resulting from the increase in the number of DNA collections under RCW 43.43.754 for lengthier hearings to address the additional DNA requirement.
