II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts

The second substitute would change the language in the new section 6 (1) to change the wording from "Subject to the availability of funds" to "Subject to the availability of amounts appropriated for this specific purpose". There is no change to the judicial impact.

This bill would add new sections to RCW 13.34 to create a Parents for Parents program. The original bill also amended RCW 13.34.030 to add subsection (23) "Veteran parent" means a parent who has successfully navigated the juvenile dependency court system, resulting in family reunification. The substitute does not amend RCW 13.34.030.

Based on input from the courts, court time will not be significantly increased.
