## II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts

This bill addresses the operation of motorcycles on roadways laned for traffic.

Section 1(b) would create a traffic infraction for an operator of a motor vehicle who intentionally impedes or attempts to prevent a motorcyclist from passing on the left-hand side as authorized in this act.

## II. B - Cash Receipts Impact

There is no data to estimate how many new traffic infractions would be issued for violation of section 1(b) of this bill. Currently the total amount of a traffic infraction is \$124. For illustrative purposes, there would need to be 404 infractions issued and paid per year to exceed \$50,000 in revenue per year.
