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Part II: Narrative Explanation

II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts

A new section would be added to RCW 11.88 to read as follows:

A county may create a guardianship courthouse facilitator program to provide basic services to pro se litigants in guardianship cases. The legislative authority of any county may impose user fees or may impose a surcharge of up to twenty dollars, or both, on superior court cases filed under chapters 11.88, 11.92, and 73.36 RCW to pay for the expenses of the guardianship courthouse facilitator program. Fees collected under this section shall be collected and deposited in the same manner as other county funds are collected and deposited, and shall be maintained in a separate guardianship courthouse facilitator account to be used as provided in this section.

II. B - Cash Receipts Impact

These are the assumptions that were used for the purposes of this judicial impact:

- 1) The number of case filings with no attorney from 2010 2014 averages 1,122 annually. If 50% of those filing without an attorney request the facilitator service, then an average of 561 people could be assessed the maximum surcharge of \$20 prior to the filing fee. The total potential revenue would be \$11,220. (561 x \$20 = \$11,220)
- 2) There are currently 9,784 cases that are still open where there is no attorney of record on the case. If 50% of those request the facilitator service, then an average of 4,892 people could be assessed the maximum surcharge of \$20. It is further assumed that 50% of 4,892 would need the service on an annual basis, 30% on a biennial basis and 20% on a triennial basis. $(50\% 2,446 \times $20 = $48,920; 30\% 1,468 \times $20 = $29,352$ and $20\% 978 \times $20 = $19,568$. Total \$48,920)

These assumptions were based on statewide totals. Not all counties will offer the program and the percentages used were for illustrative purposes and could be higher or lower.

II. C - Expenditures

There is no expenditure impact to the courts or to AOC. It is assumed the revenue received would pay for the facilitator program.
