II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts

RCW 28A.225.020 would be amended to add section (4). RCW 28A.225.020 (4) Subject to the availability of funds, administrative office of the courts must complete validation of the Washington assessment of risk and needs of students for high school students not later than August 30, 2015, develop and validate Washington assessments of risk and needs for middle school and elementary school students not later than August 30, 2016, and report the status of the tool development and validation by January 1st of each calendar year until development and validation are complete.

The tool for high school has been completed and there is currently work on the middle school and elementary school students . Therefore, there would be no AOC or court impact.
