**Part II: Narrative Explanation**

**II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts**

Section 2 of this bill would repeal RCW 77.12.201. This law requires counties to remit to the State Treasurers Office, an amount equal to the amounts collected for fines, fees and forfeitures for violations of title 77 game laws, if electing to receive payments in lieu of taxes (PILT) from WDFW.

There would be no fiscal impact to the courts. It is the local county governments that are currently required to remit an amount that is equal to the fines and fees collected by the courts. Section 2 of this bill would repeal this requirement for county governments.
