Part II: Narrative Explanation

II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts

This draft bill would add a new section to RCW 43.88C to require the caseload forecast council to develop and provide the legislature, upon request, with racial and ethnic impact statement on any legislative proposal.

Section 2(2) would require the administrative office of the courts to provide the caseload forecast council with data, information and data processing assistance without charge.

New Section 3(1) would require the administrative office of the courts to assist the caseload forecast council with establishing a procedure for providing racial impact statements.

Administrative office of the courts already provides information, data processing assistance, and other assistance to the caseload forecast council. The assistance required by this bill would be done using current resources.
