II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts

This bill addresses adjudicative proceedings by state agencies . It would require a presiding officer in an internal agency administrative hearing to issue final orders, not initial orders. The administrative law judges used by state agencies in these adjudicative proceedings would not be judges of the superior, district, or municipal courts .
