This bill would require the Office of Minority and Women's Business Enterprises (OMWBE) to annually identify state agencies and educational institutions with low levels of participation by minority and women-owned businesses in the execution of public contracts.

The bill would establish an investigation unit within the OMWBE.

The bill would repeal the authority of the Office of the Attorney General (OAG) to investigate and enforce compliance with certain requirements regarding contracts with minority and women-owned businesses.

The bill would modify the small works roster and limited public works requirements.
