Part II: Narrative Explanation

This bill would provide that nothing in the state civil rights act would prohibit a public or private entity from limiting access to a private facility segregated by gender to a person if the person is preoperative, non-operative, or otherwise has genitalia of a different gender from that for which the facility is segregated.

Part II.A – Brief Description of what the Measure does that has fiscal impact on the Courts

This bill would amend RCW 49.60.030 (Freedom from Discrimination – Declaration of Civil Rights) adding Section 1(4) to state that nothing in RCW 49.60.030 would prohibit a public or private entity from limiting access to a private facility segregated by gender, such as a bathroom, restroom, toilet, shower, locker room, or sauna, to a person if the person is pre-operative, non-operative, or otherwise has genitalia of a different gender from that for which the facility is segregated; and the bill would provide that nothing in RCW 49.60.030 would grant any right to a person to access a private facility segregated by gender, such as a bathroom, restroom, toilet, shower, locker room, or sauna, of a public or private entity if the person is pre-operative, non-operative, or otherwise has genitalia of a different gender from that for which the facility is segregated.
