## **Part II: Narrative Explanation**

### **II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts**

RCW 69.50.4013 would be amended to allow a person 21 or older to possess no more than 6 marijuana plants and up to 24 ounces of useable marijuana harvested from lawfully grown plants. Plants must be grown and possessed within the premises of the person's housing unit and not removed in amounts over 1 ounce. No more than 12 plants and 48 ounces of useable marijuana may be possessed by all adult residents of a single housing unit.
