## **Part II: Narrative Explanation**

This bill would amend RCW 9A.04.080 to eliminate the statute of limitations for prosecution of specific sex-related crimes:

- 1) Rape in the first, second, or third degree;
- 2) Rape of a child in the first, second, or third degree;
- 3) Child molestation in the first, second, or third degree;
- 4) Sexual misconduct with a minor in the first degree;
- 5) Indecent liberties;
- 6) Sexually violating human remains;
- 7) Voyeurism;
- 8) Custodial sexual misconduct in the first degree;
- 9) Incest in the first or second degree;
- 10) Sexual exploitation of a minor;
- 11) Communication with a minor for immoral purposes;
- 12) Commercial sexual abuse of a minor;
- 13) Promoting commercial sexual abuse of a minor; and
- 14) Promoting travel for commercial sexual abuse of a minor.

### **Part II.A – Brief Description of what the Measure does that has fiscal impact on the Courts**

Section 1 – Would amend RCW 9A.04.080 to allow for prosecution of certain sex-related offenses at any time after their commission.
