## **Part II: Narrative Explanation**

This bill would amend RCW 9A.88.110 to clarify the location at which the misdemeanor crime of patronizing a prostitute occurs. The crime is deemed to have been committed in any location in which the defendant commits any act under subsection 9A.88.110(1)(a), (b), or (c). Further, a person who sends a communication to patronize a prostitute is considered to have committed the crime both at the place from which the contact was made and where the communication is received.
