Part II: Narrative Explanation

This bill would amend RCW 13.40.510 to add referred youth, as well as adjudicated juvenile offenders to receive services for programs that may be funded under RCW 13.40.500 through RCW 13.40.540.

Some funding formulas may need to be changed which could affect some counties.

No impact to the courts.

NOTE: This bill differs from 1280 HB by providing a definition of referred youth and requires that the Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) report on the number of youth who were eligible for community juvenile accountability programs based on being a referred youth.
