Part II: Narrative Explanation

This bill would provide that it is a gross misdemeanor for a resident to register an off-road vehicle or snowmobile in another state and not apply for a Washington state certificate of title within fifteen days of having brought the vehicle into Washington to avoid the payment of a tax or license fee imposed by Washington.

The bill would require motorsports vehicle manufacturers to report to the Washington Department of Licensing (DOL) a listing of motorsports vehicle warranties for off-road vehicles and snowmobiles registered to residents of Washington but sold by out-of-state dealers during the previous calendar year.

Part II.A – Brief Description of what the Measure does that has fiscal impact on the Courts

This bill would add new sections to RCW 46.09, RCW 46.10, and RCW 46.93 creating two new gross misdemeanors related to registration and licensing of snowmobiles.

The law tables would need to be updated, and additional account coding added. This could be managed within existing resources.
