Part II: Narrative Explanation

This bill would affect provisions of RCW 41.80 (public employment, civil service, and pensions) to address resolution of labor disputes concerning uniformed personnel (officers employed as members of a police force).

This bill would create an arbitration panel that may invoke the jurisdiction of a Superior Court in the event a person disobeys the panel's authority as to hearings.

The bill would provide that the panel's written determination of issues in dispute is subject to review by the Superior Court solely as to whether the decision was arbitrary or capricious.

Part II.A – Brief Description of what the Measure does that has fiscal impact on the Courts

Section 5 – Would create an arbitration panel to address resolution of labor disputes concerning uniformed personnel (police officers). Would provide for the arbitration panel to invoke the jurisdiction and authority of a Superior Court in the event that a person does not adhere to the arbitration panel's authority regarding hearings.

II.C – Expenditures

This bill could have impact on the Superior Courts, but there is no data to estimate the number of hearings that could result. The Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) believes the impact on the Superior Courts would be minimal.
