II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts

RCW 9.94A.589 (1)(b) would be amended to state that Unless the court expressly orders that the community custody terms run consecutively to each other, such terms shall run concurrently to each other even if the court orders the confinement terms to run consecutively to each other. RCW 9.94A.589 (2)(a) would be amended to say that any terms of community custody shall run concurrently to each other, unless the court pronouncing the current sentence expressly orders that they be served consecutively .
