## Part II: Narrative Explanation

This bill would amend RCW 66.44.010 to expand the authority of the Liquor and Cannabis Board (LCB) to enforce penal and traffic laws relating to the manufacture, import, transportation, possession, distribution and sale of liquor, marijuana, tobacco, and vapor products as well as the penal and traffic laws relating to impaired driving of patrons near locations licensed by the LCB. The enforcement power would be extended to liquor enforcement officers employed by the LCB along with the associated authority to serve and execute warrants and the authority to arrest.

## Part II.A – Brief Description of what the Measure does that has fiscal impact on the Courts

Indeterminate. While there may be additional charges filed, there is no data to estimate how many there would be resulting from this bill. Impact is expected to be minimal.

Court education would be required. This could be managed within existing resources.
