Engrossed substitute bill:

In addition to the proposed original bill, RCW 7.90.170 would be amended to allow a court to modify firearms restrictions in a sexual assault protection order. Based on information from the program staff, there may be some impact, however, it is expected to be less than \$50,000 per year.

Original Bill:

RCW 7.90.120 would be amended to read that a final sexual assault protection order shall be effective for a fixed period of time or be permanent. Previous language read (not to exceed two years).

RCW 7.90.121 would be amended to change the re-motion procedure with the burden shifted to the respondent and limiting factors that can be considered by the court.
