## **Part II: Narrative Explanation**

This bill would amend RCW 2.32.050, clarifying the duties of court clerks.

### **Part II.A – Brief Description of what the Measure does that has fiscal impact on the Courts**

This bill would provide that county clerks must keep minutes of court proceedings instead of a journal of court proceedings. The clerk of the court would no longer be required to forward monthly residential time summary reports to the Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) Division of Child Support (DCS). The DCS would no longer be required to compile and report information in the residential time summary reports to the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC). The AOC would no longer be required to annual report the compiled information.
