Part II: Narrative Explanation

II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts

RCW 7.84.100 would be amended to state that for counties with a population of less than one hundred thousand on the effective date of this section, the county treasurer shall remit seventy-five percent of the money received under RCW 79A.80.080(5) to the state treasurer. In all other counties, the county treasurer shall remit all money received under RCW 79A.80.080(5) to the state treasurer.

II. B - Cash Receipts Impact

Based on information from Parks, in 2016, State Parks, WDFW and DNR issued citation fines of \$196,436 in 17 counties with populations of less than 100,000. Based on an estimate of \$200,000, 25% of the funds would constitute a \$50,000 loss in revenue to State Parks and a \$50,000 revenue increase to the adjudicating counties.
