II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts

New sections would be added to RCW 36.70A that would mandate steps that must be taken for public school building projects that are outside the urban growth area.

RCW 36.70A.280 would be amended to state that only the courts have the authority to review causes of action arising from sections 1 and 2 of this act and must give substantial deference to the actions of the county in which a permit has been granted to site a school outside of the urban growth area, and to a determination of need under section 1 of this act.

Although this may lead to a few court cases, the impact will be minimal.
