Part II: Narrative Explanation

This bill would establish the Campus Free Expression Act and the Academic Freedom and Whistleblower Protection Act. The bill would create an Academic Bill of Rights.

Part II.A – Brief Description of what the Measure does that has fiscal impact on the Courts

This bill would introduce the following causes of action: violation of the campus free expression act (Section 2); violation of the right to discretionary trigger warnings (Section 3); violation of the campus anti-harassment act (Section 4); violation of the academic freedom and whistleblower protection act (Section 5); and violation of students' rights in disciplinary proceedings with a potential penalty of expulsion (Section 6).
