Part II: Narrative Explanation

This bill would amend RCW 9A.76.140, 9A.76.150, and 9A.76.160 to add the element of use of an unmanned aircraft with the intent to deliver a deadly weapon (first degree), to deliver contraband with intent to assist in escape or commission of a crime (second degree), or to deliver contraband (third degree) to a person confined in a detention facility or secure facility.

Part II.A – Brief Description of what the Measure does that has fiscal impact on the Courts

Section 1(5) – Would define “unmanned aircraft” to mean an aircraft that is operated without the possibility of direct human intervention from within or on such an aircraft.

Section 2(b) – Would amend RCW 9A.76.140 to provide that a person who uses an unmanned aircraft to deliver, or attempt to deliver, any deadly weapon to any person confined in a detention or secure facility would be guilty of introducing contraband in the first degree.

Section 3(b) – Would amend RCW 9A.76.150 to provide that a person who uses an unmanned aircraft to deliver, or attempt to deliver, contraband to any person confined in a detention facility or secure facility with the intent that such contraband be of assistance in an escape or commission of a crime would be guilty of introducing contraband in the second degree.

Section 4(b) – Would amend RCW 9A.76.160 to provide that a person who uses an unmanned aircraft to deliver, or attempt to deliver, contraband to any person confined in a detention or secure facility would be guilty of introducing contraband in the third degree.

II.C – Expenditures

It is unknown how many attempts would be made to deliver contraband into detention or secure facilities via the use of unmanned aircraft. Impact on the courts is expected to be minimal.
