Part II: Narrative Explanation

This bill would prohibit the possession, sale, offer for sale, purchase or otherwise transfer of any large capacity magazine, unless otherwise authorized by statute. A person in violation would be guilty of a gross misdemeanor punishable under RCW 9A.20.

Part II.A – Brief Description of what the Measure does that has fiscal impact on the Courts

Section 1(12) – Would define “large capacity magazine” to mean an ammunition feeding device with the capacity to accept more than ten rounds of ammunition, or any conversion kit, part, or combination of parts, from which such a device can be assembled if those parts are in the possession or under the control of the same person, but shall not be construed to include any of the following:

- (a) An ammunition feeding device that has been permanently altered so that it cannot accommodate more than ten rounds of ammunition;
- (b) A twenty-two caliber tube ammunition feeding device;
- (c) A tubular magazine that is contained in a lever-action firearm.

Section 2(4) – A person who violates this act would be guilty of a gross misdemeanor.

II.C – Expenditures

Indeterminate. There is no data available to provide an estimate of filings or trial court impact resulting from this bill, but impact is expected to be minimal.

The law tables would need to be updated for all court levels, adding the new gross misdemeanor. This would be accomplished within existing resources.
