Part II: Narrative Explanation

This bill would provide that a person under the age of eighteen and suspected of committing the crime of prostitution from being charged or prosecuted for a prostitution offense or booked into detention for a prostitution offense.

Law enforcement would be required, before completing a law enforcement contact with a person who is under the age of eighteen and suspected of prostitution, to make a child abuse or neglect report, deliver the person to an evaluation and treatment facility, or refer the person to other appropriate services.

Part II.A – Brief Description of what the Measure does that has fiscal impact on the Courts

Section 2 would amend RCW 9A.88.030 to create special provisions for persons under the age of eighteen who are suspected of committing the crime of prostitution.
