Part II: Narrative Explanation

This bill would prohibit a person from carrying a concealed firearm into the residence of another person without first obtaining permission. It would require the court, upon conviction for a violation to order the person to surrender any concealed pistol license and prohibit the person from obtaining another one for five years.

Part II.A – Brief Description of what the Measure does that has fiscal impact on the Courts

A new section would be added to RCW 9.41 that would prohibit a person from carrying a concealed firearm into the residence of another person without first obtaining permission. A person would be guilty of a misdemeanor. Upon conviction for a violation of this section, the court would order the person to surrender any concealed pistol license and prohibit the person from obtaining a concealed pistol license for a period of five years from the date of the conviction.

RCW 9.41.075 would be amended to state (1) The license shall be revoked by the license-issuing authority immediately upon: (c) Conviction of the licensee of an offense under section 1 of this act.

There will be impact to the court from increased filings but this is expected to be minimal. The clerks will need to send notification to the Department of Licensing.
