## **Part II: Narrative Explanation**

This bill would require a court to hold an evidentiary hearing to review certain information before granting a conditional release or a less restrictive alternative for a person committed as a sexually violent predator, if the release is to a county other than the county of commitment.

Indeterminate, but impact is expected to be minimal. There may be a few additional hearings required, but no data exists to estimate the number of these hearings.
