Part II: Narrative Explanation

Would require that any person or entity that operates a web site that collects, through internet web site analytics, health care information or any data from which conclusions or judgements can be made or inferred about an individual's health status or condition must obtain written consent of the individual and implement administrative and technical safeguards to protect the privacy of the individual's health care information.

Part II.A – Brief Description of what the Measure does that has fiscal impact on the Courts

Section 1(1) - This section would add a new chapter to 70.01 RCW requiring that any person or entity that operates a web site that collects, through internet web site analytics, health care information or any data from which conclusions or judgements can be made or inferred about an individual's health status or condition must obtain written consent of the individual and implement administrative and technical safeguards to protect the privacy of the individual's health care information.

Section 1(2) – Would allow a person to maintain an action for relief against a person or entity that operates a web site under subsection (1) of this section who fails to comply or its contractor fails to comply with the requirements of subsection (1) in the same manner as relief may be sought against a health care provider or facility under RCW 70.02.170.

II.B - Cash Receipt Impact

Indeterminate; there could be an increase in filing fees, however, there is no data available to determine the increase in new cases filed as a result of this bill.

II.C - Expenditures
