Part II: Narrative Explanation

This bill would amend several domestic violence statutes to add "intimate partner" and update or change definitions. The bill would create instances where Assault in the Fourth Degree is elevated to a Class C felony.

Part II.A – Brief Description of what the Measure does that has fiscal impact on the Courts

Sections 1 through 18 would amend various domestic violence statutes to add "intimate partner".

Section 7 – Would create instances where Assault in the Fourth Degree is elevated to a Class C felony, if a person has two or more prior adult convictions within ten years for any of a variety of listed offenses where domestic violence against an intimate partner was pleaded and proven after July 23, 2017.
