This bill would make a person eighteen years of age or older guilty of the crime of unlawful purchase of a firearm if they know they are prohibited by state law from purchasing or possessing a firearm and the person purchases or attempts to purchase a firearm.

Part II.A – Brief Description of what the Measure does that has fiscal impact on the Courts

Section 1(1) – Would make a person eighteen years of age or older guilty of the crime of unlawful purchase of a firearm if they know they are prohibited by state law from purchasing or possessing a firearm and the person purchases or attempts to purchase a firearm.

Section 1(2) – Would make unlawful purchase of a firearm a class C felony punishable according to Chapter 9A.20 RCW.
