This bill would modify student attendance requirements and generally provide updated student attendance communication guidelines for school district communications with parents.

Part II.A – Brief Description of what the Measure does that has fiscal impact on the Courts

Section 101(3) - Would allow for school districts to file a petition for civil action under RCW 28A.225.035 after the child has had five unexcused absences in a month (the current law is seven unexcused absences in a month).

Section 101(4) - Would require school districts to file a petition for civil action under RCW 28A.225.035 after the student has accumulated fifteen unexcused absences in a month or cumulative unexcused absences in a school year.

Section 104 – Would change the community truancy board title to community engagement board under RCW 28A.225.025.
