Part II: Narrative Explanation

This bill would require law enforcement to provide juveniles with access to an attorney prior to any waiver of the juvenile's constitutional rights when law enforcement questions a juvenile after providing a Miranda warning or briefly detains a juvenile based on reasonable suspicion.

This bill would expand RCW 2.70.020 requiring that the Office of Public Defense provide juveniles questioned or briefly detained by law enforcement access to an attorney.

Part II.A – Brief Description of what the Measure does that has fiscal impact on the Courts

Section 1 – Would require that law enforcement provide juveniles with access to an attorney prior to any waiver of the juvenile's constitutional rights when law enforcement questions a juvenile after providing a Miranda warning or briefly detains a juvenile based on reasonable suspicion.

Section 3(1)(g) – Would require that the Office of Public Defense provide access to attorneys when juveniles are contacted by law information for questioning under Section 1 of this act.
