## Part II: Narrative Explanation

This bill would amend child support income withholding provisions to comply with federal child support program requirements.

### Part II.A – Brief Description of what the Measure does that has fiscal impact on the Courts

Sections 1 and 2 – Would remove language in RCW 6.27.105 requiring a writ of lien for child support to have the caption “this garnishment is based on a judgement or order for child support.”

Section 4(2) – Would amend RCW 6.27.330 removing child support continuing liens from its language and would allow a judgment creditor to seek to withhold from earnings based on a judgement or other order for child support under RCW 26.18.

Section 5(16) – Would add a definition of income withholding order to mean “an order regarding withhold of income in amounts payable as a support obligation that complies with requirements in Federal Code Title 42. U.S.C. Sec 666.”
