Part II: Narrative Explanation

This bill would address the continued public education of youth released from institutional facilities. This bill would define institutional education facilities to include county juvenile detention centers and would require annual staff training that builds academic strategies specific to students involved in the juvenile justice system.

Part II.A – Brief Description of what the Measure does that has fiscal impact on the Courts

Section 12(3)(a) – Would form an institutional education structure and accountability advisory group for the purpose of providing advice and information to the Office of Public Instruction and Department of Children, Youth and Families in meeting the requirements of subsection (1) of this section. The group would include representatives from:

- (i) The State Board of Education
- (ii) The Department of Social And Health Services
- (iii) A statewide organization representing counties
- (iv) The Administrative Office of the Courts
- (v) The Office of the Education Ombuds
- (vi) The Educational Opportunity Gap Oversight and Accountability Committee
- (vii) A statewide organization representing teachers
- (viii) A statewide organization representing classified education staff
- (ix) Nonprofit organizations representing the interest of your and families involved in the juvenile justice system
- (x) Persons who are or have been involved in the juvenile justice system and their families and
- (xi) A statewide organization representing state employees

Section 13(3) – Would require that the Education Data Center established in subsection (1) of this section develop data-sharing agreements with the Administrative Office of the Courts for the purpose of conducting research on educational and workforce outcomes using data related to juveniles in the court system. RCW 13.50.010(12)
