#### **Part II: Narrative Explanation**

This bill would prohibit open carry of a firearm or any other weapon while participating or attending any demonstration being held in a public place and to knowingly carry any weapon on the state capitol grounds or any location where there is a public legislative hearing or meeting.

# Part II.A – Brief Description of what the Measure does that has fiscal impact on the Courts

Section 1(2)(a) – Would prohibit open carry of firearms or other weapons at public demonstrations.

Section 1(2)(b) – Would make it unlawful for any person to carry a firearm or other weapons within one thousand feet of a public demonstration after a duly authorized law enforcement officer has advised the person of the demonstration.

Section 1(2)(d) – Would define for the purposes of this subsection;

- (i) A demonstration as conduct by one more persons communicating views or grievances which has the effect or intent of attracting a crowd. This includes but is not limited to, a march, rally vigil, sit-in or picketing.
- (ii) A public place means any site accessible to the general public for business, entertainment or other lawful purpose. This includes, but on limited too a parking lot of place of business, any public building and its surrounding area, sidewalk or any other public grounds.

Section 2(1) – Would add a new chapter to RCW 9.41 prohibiting the open carry of a firearm or any other weapon on the state capitol grounds, in any state legislative office or any location where there is a public legislative hearing or meeting.

Section (2)(3) – Any person violating Section 2 of this bill would be guilty of a gross misdemeanor.
