This bill would amend RCW 9A.48.110 Defacing a State Monument by expanding what defines state property and would include statutes, memorials and property owned by any public body.

This bill would also increase the penalty for the crime from a misdemeanor to a class C felony.

Part II.A – Brief Description of what the Measure does that has fiscal impact on the Courts

Section 1(1) – Would expand what defines state property to include any statue, monument, or memorial owned by a public body.

Section 1(2) – Would define public body to mean Federal Government and the State of Washington, its agencies, institutions, political subdivisions and municipal and quasi-municipal corporations.

Section 1(3) – Would increase the penalty for the crime of defacing a public monument from a misdemeanor to a class C felony.
