Part II: Narrative Explanation

This bill would add a new section to RCW 9.41 Firearms and Dangerous Weapons, making manufacturing, possession, distribution, importing, and transferring, a large capacity magazine a gross misdemeanor.

Part II.A – Brief Description of what the Measure does that has fiscal impact on the Courts

Section 2(36) – Would define a "large capacity magazine to mean an ammunition feeding device with the ability to accept more than 10 rounds of ammunition.

Section 3(1) – Would make it illegal to own, possess, transfer, sell, or offer for sale a large capacity magazine.

Section 3(2) – This section would exempt certain individuals from subsection (1) of this section.

Section 3(4) – Would make a person who violates this section guilty of gross misdemeanor punishable under chapter 9A.20 RCW.
