II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts

This bill creates the crime of disclosing fabricated intimate images.

Section 1 adds new definitions

New Sections 2.4 and 2.6 creates a new class B felony for various acts surrounding the fabrication of images of minors engaging in sexually explicit conduct

New Section 3 creates new gross and simple misdemeanors for anyone under the age of 18 engaging in the conduct outlined in sec. 2, including the minor themselves; when the minor depicted is 12 years of age or younger, the crime is upgraded to class B felony

New Section 15 creates a new gross misdemeanor for the first offense of disclosing fabricated intimate images; additional violations are class C felonies

New Section 21 creates a new civil cause of action for a depicted individual who is identifiable, suffered harm from the intentional or threatened disclosure of the images, and did not give consent, as defined under the section, for such disclosure
