The engrossed bill would have the same, minimal impact as the original version.

It would create a new section under Chapter 9.94A RCW that allows driving under the influence (DUI) offenders to seek special drug offender sentence alternative considerations (DOSA-DUI). The bill would also add a new definition for DOSA-DUI and extend the look back period for felony DUI from 10 years to 15 Years.
